<p>Martin Luther King, Jr. National Historic Site: The Martin Luther King, Jr. National Historic site was established to preserve and interpret the places where Dr. King was born, worked, worshipped and is buried. Places to visit include the Visitor Center, Ebenezer Baptist Church, The King Center (Freedom Hall), Fire Station No. 6, Dr. King's Birth Home and the restored Birth Home Block. Important Note: This is a self-guided walking tour. The National Women's Studies Association will provide transportation and arrange for two groups of 15 (the maximum allowed) to enter the birth home. Entry to the birth home is on the hour. You must be among the first 30 tour registrants if you would like to tour the birth home as part of the NWSA trip. Also note that the birth home is not wheelchair accessible.</p> <p>High Museum of Art Atlanta: The High Museum of Art is the leading art museum in the Southeastern United States with its renowned collection of classic and contemporary art and renowned architecture by Richard Meier and Renzo Piano. The NWSA visit will consist of a docent-led tour that highlights works by women artists in the museum's permanent collection. When the guided tour is complete, participants may browse the collection.</p>
